- \* Expansion also occurs when the long-term use of some drugs induce new disease. Millions of people take drugs to lower cholesterol, while the drug is also increasing the risk of cancer.
- \* To safeguard the industry, drug companies withhold important information from consumers that has the potential to save thousands of lives. Then, they discredit natural healthcare remedies and issue false reports of adverse reactions to these natural remedies.
